
About Clarkson Youth Hub

Clarkson Youth Hub has been designed as a safe and welcoming space for young people to socialise with their peers and connect with services and information. Function rooms, meeting rooms and offices are available for youth focused community groups and organisations to hire for one-off or regular programs.

Situated adjacent to Clarkson Skate Park, the Youth Hub is across the road from the busy Ocean Keys Shopping Centre and close to the popular Clarkson Library and. This provides high foot traffic and valuable opportunities to engage with young people and families.

Spaces: There are a variety of spaces available including a Function Room, Youth Room with adjoining kitchen, two smaller meeting rooms, three small offices and one large office. The Youth Hub is part of a larger youth area that includes an outdoor table tennis table, a skate park, BMX track and BBQ area.

Submission Criteria

The City of Wanneroo envisages Clarkson Youth Hub to offer a services, programs, workshops and events from one or more of the following four focus areas:

Connection and Inclusion

Fostering a socially active, inclusive and supportive community

This includes programs, events or activities that encourage community connection and celebration of diversity and inclusion.

Wellbeing

Supporting a safe, healthy and happy community

This includes services or programs that support and encourage positive health outcomes for young people.

Lifelong Learning

Enabling a curious, creative and skilled community

This includes activities, workshops and programs that provide opportunities for young people to learn, develop and grow.

Engagement and Empowerment

Building a culture of participation and leadership in the community

This involves empowering young people with opportunities to contribute their voice and be involved and celebrated in their local community.

Priority will be given to groups and organisations who are able to assist the City in delivering youth programs and services in line with the following criteria:

- Able to provide a reputable program/service that meets one (or more) of the four identified focus areas.
- Inclusive, with consideration given to the needs of the City's diverse population.
- Delivered primarily to City of Wanneroo residents.
- Free or low cost for participants.
- Willing to provide the City with reports and statistics based on engagement and program outcomes.
- Able to provide evidence of insurance and other required documents.
- Willing to support the City's commitment to Child Safety, the National Principles for Child Safe organisations and the WA Youth Work Code of Ethics.
